STANDING ORDER 24-001

VACATING PRIOR STANDING ORDERS

The purpose of this standing order is to address prior standing orders.

WHEREAS, Article IV of the Grand Ronde Constitution vests authority to the Chief Judge to exercise all judicial authority of the Tribe, to include the power to review and overturn tribal legislative and executive actions.

WHEREAS, Tribal Court Ordinance Chapter 302 provides for the administration of law and justice by the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde through the establishment of a Tribal Court system as required by Article IV of the Grand Ronde Constitution.

WHEREAS, Tribal Court Ordinance Chapter 302 empowers the court to exercise the judicial authority of the Tribe as delegated herein.

WHEREAS, there are currently outdated standing orders in effect.

THEREFORE, the 2010-01 (Amended) Temporary Standing Order is considered moot and hereby vacated.

This order shall remain in effect until further notice or until superseded by future order.
